16	Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1 and inserting in its place the following:
18	'Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §2902, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1969, c. 193,
20	is amended to read:
22	1. Individuals. Any individual of sound mind and <u>at least</u> <u>16 years</u> of <del>legal</del> age may give all or any part of his <u>that</u>
24	individual's body for any purposes specified in section 2903, the gift to take effect upon death.'
26	Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the
28	statement of fact the following:
30	FISCAL NOTE
32	The costs associated with issuing additional decals and other administrative responsibilities will be absorbed by the
34	Division of Motor Vehicles utilizing existing budgeted resources.'
