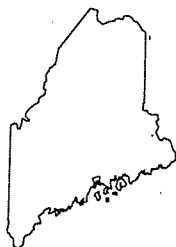

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

This bill provides a General Fund appropriation for treatment of individuals with a dual diagnosis. These services will be provided through a contract with the Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation and a hospital located in the Portland area.
