

An Act Concerning Postsecondary Student Immunization Requirements.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

20-A MRSA §6359, sub-§1, ¶C, as enacted by PL 1985, c. 771, §§2 and 7, is amended to read:

C. "Disease" means diphtheria, measles, and rubella and tetanus.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill removes diphtheria and tetanus from the postsecondary immunization requirements.
