14	state mandate law, an additional General Fund appropriation of \$75,000 in fiscal year 1992-93 is required by the Department of
16	Education, Reimbursement for State Mandates, to reimburse school units for 100% of the costs incurred for seat belt maintenance

,20	The Department of Transportation and the Department of Education can absorb the costs related to the rulemaking required

20	This amendment removes the requirement in the bill that
