An Act to Increase the Minimum Age to Enter School.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

20-A MRSA §5201, sub-§2, as enacted by PL 1981, c. 693, §§5 4 and 8, is amended to read: 6 2. Minimum ages. The following are minimum ages necessary for student enrollment in a school administrative unit. 8 A. A person who will-be is at least 6 years old on Oetober 15th May 31st of the immediately preceding school year may 10 enroll in grade one. 12 B. A person who will-be is at least 5 years old on Oetober 15th May 31st of the immediately preceding school year may 14 enroll in a one-year kindergarten if it is offered. 16 C. A person who will-be is at least 4 years old on Oetober 15th May 31st of the immediately preceding school year may 18 enroll in a 2-year childhood education program prior to grade one if it is offered. 20 22 STATEMENT OF FACT 24 This bill raises by 4 1/2 months the minimum age for 26 enrolling children in 2-year preschool programs, kindergarten and first grade.
