4	and bridge damage. The future maintenance and repair costs can not be determined.
6	The additional workload and administrative costs associated

2	STATEMENT OF FACT

6	This amendment allows haulers of sand, gravel or stone to apply for a special commodity permit to extend truck weight
8	limits to those limits now available to haulers of forest products. This amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
