COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 221, L.D. 312, Bill, "An Act to Clarify the Powers and Duties of the Department of Administration, through the Bureau of Purchases"

Amend the bill in subsection 5, in the last line (page 1, line 12 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "district" and inserting in its place the following: 'unit'

Further amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

**'FISCAL NOTE**

This bill will allow political subdivisions and school administrative units to purchase goods from the Bureau of Purchases' central warehouse. Additional purchases by local governmental units will increase dedicated revenue to the Postal, Printing and Supply Fund, an internal service fund. The amount of additional revenue can not be determined at this time but will be sufficient to cover the additional costs incurred by the bureau. No allocation of funds is necessary.'

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

This amendment brings the language of the bill into conformity with the description of administrative school unit in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, section 1, subsection 26 and adds a fiscal note.
