5. Storerooms. To establish and operate, with the approval of the Commissioner of Administration, such storerooms which, in the judgment of the State Purchasing Agent, are deemed determined necessary for the storage and distribution of supplies, materials and equipment required for use by the State Government or any department or agency thereef, or any political subdivision or school administrative district;

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill requires the Bureau of Purchases to include political subdivisions and school administrative districts in determining the amount of storerooms necessary to store supplies.
