**An Act to Clarify the Powers and Duties of the Department of
Administration, through the Bureau of Purchases.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 5 MRSA §1811, sub-§5, as amended by PL 1985, c. 785, Pt. A,
§71, is further amended to read:

6 5. Storerooms. To establish and operate, with the approval
of the Commissioner of Administration, such storerooms which, in
8 the judgment of the State Purchasing Agent, are deemed determined
10 necessary for the storage and distribution of supplies, materials
and equipment required for use by the State Government or any
12 department or agency thereof, or any political subdivision or
school administrative district;

16 STATEMENT OF FACT

18 This bill requires the Bureau of Purchases to include
political subdivisions and school administrative districts in
20 determining the amount of storerooms necessary to store supplies.
