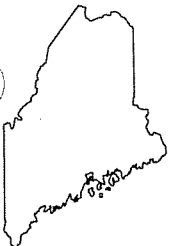

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**An Act to Amend the Election Laws Dealing with Local Elections.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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30-A MRSA §2528, sub-§4, ¶B, as amended by PL 1989, c. 104,  
4 Pt. A, §18 and Pt. C, §§8 and 10, is further amended to read:

6 B. At the end of the list of candidates for each office,  
7 there shall must be left as many blank spaces as there are  
8 vacancies to be filled in which a voter may write in the  
9 name ~~and-municipality-of-residence~~ of any person for whom  
10 the voter desires to vote. A sticker may not be used to  
11 vote for a write-in candidate in any municipal election  
12 other than a primary election.

16 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

17 Current law requires that voters include the municipality of  
18 residence along with the name of any write-in candidates. This  
19 bill deletes the requirement that the municipality be included  
20 for municipal elections.
