COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "*A*" to H.P. 226, L.D. 317, Bill, "An Act Concerning the Role of Guardians Ad Litem and Other Children's Advocates"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'22 MRSA §4041, sub§-3 is enacted to read:

3. Notice to guardian ad litem. The department shall notify the guardian ad litem, as described in section 4005, of any substantial change in circumstances that may have an impact on the best interests of the child.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment relocates the language of the bill to a more appropriate section of the law.
