An Act to Prohibit Telephone Solicitation in Maine.



2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 17-A MRSA §517 is enacted to read:

6 §517. Telephone solicitation

8 A person is guilty of solicitation by telephone if that
10 person intentionally uses a telephone to solicit trade or
12 contributions for any purpose other than the direct advancement
14 of a nonprofit organization, agency or corporation. Telephone
16 solicitation is a Class E crime.

18 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

This bill makes the use of a telephone to solicit trade or contributions for any purpose other than the direct advancement of a nonprofit organization, agency or corporation a Class E crime.
