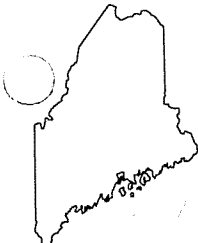

**An Act to Allow Spouses of School Board Members to Work for the
Same School District.**



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

20-A MRSA §1002, sub-§2, as enacted by PL 1981, c. 693, §§5 and 8, is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill repeals the prohibition against full-time employment of:

1. A school board member or the spouse of a school board member in a public school located within the jurisdiction of the school board to which the member is elected; and

2. A union committee member or the spouse of a union committee member in a contract high school or academy located within the jurisdiction of the union committee to which the member is elected.
