12 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 251, L.D. 342, Bill, "An
14 Act to Revise the Composition of the Board of Trustees of the University of Maine System"

Amend the bill by striking out all of sections 2 and 3 and 18 inserting in their place the following:

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'Sec. 2. P&SL 1865, c. 532, §4, sub-§2, as amended by PL 1983, c. 799, §4, is further amended to read:

2. Members appointed by the Governor. Fourteen members 24 shall-be are appointed for 5-year terms by the Governor, subject to review by the joint standing committee of the Legislature 26 having jurisdiction over education and confirmation by the Legislature. Each term shall-expire expires on May 26th of the 28 appropriate year, except that the retiring member shall serve until a successor is appointed by the Governor and confirmed by 30 the Legislature. No person accepting such an appointment may be member of the State Board of Education. In making а 32 appointments, the Governor shall strive to achieve a membership In-so which is representative of the population of this State. 34 far Insofar as feasible when selecting qualified nominees to the board, the Governor shall consider affirmative action criteria, 36 professional education and experience and an equitable geographical representation among the members. <u>One of the</u> 38 trustees must be a faculty trustee who has a doctoral degree and is a teaching faculty member and not an administrator. Every 5th 40 year, the Chancellor of the University of Maine System shall solicit a list of 6 eliqible faculty members from the faculty senates from 6 of the campuses within the University of Maine 42 System; the 7th campus being excluded in accordance with this 44 subsection. The Governor shall then nominate a faculty trustee

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chosen from the list. The faculty trustee may not come from the same campus in any 2 consecutive terms. The faculty trustee is 2 prohibited from voting on faculty collective bargaining agreements and faculty tenure decisions. Trustees Nonfaculty 4 trustees may serve a maximum of 2 terms, except that an individual appointed to fill an unexpired term of 3 years or less б is eligible for appointment to 2 full terms. Vacancies shall 8 must be filled by the Governor, subject to review by the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over education and confirmation by the Legislature, for the unexpired 10 balance of the term. In order to restore and maintain rotation 12 of terms of office of trustees, an incumbent trustee who was appointed for a term of 5 years at a time subsequent to the expiration of the term of his the trustee's predecessor in office 14 shall-be is deemed to have commenced his the 5-year term upon the 16 date of the expiration of the term of office of his the trustee's predecessor rather than from the date of his appointment and 18 gualification. Trustees shall serve without compensation, but may be reimbursed for travel and other expenses incurred in the 20 performance of their official duties.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment revises the composition of the Board of Trustees of the University of Maine System to include one teaching faculty member and adds a selection provision for the faculty trustee. The amendment also prohibits appointment of a faculty trustee from the same campus in any 2 consecutive terms and prohibits a faculty trustee from voting on tenure and faculty collective bargaining agreements.
