IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE

An Act to Revise the Composition of the Board of Trustees of the University of Maine System.



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Sec. 1. P&SL 1865, c. 532, §4, sub-§1, as repealed and replaced by P&SL 1983, c. 33, \$1, is amended to read:

 - Sec. 2. P&SL 1865, c. 532, §4, sub-§2, as amended by PL 1983, c. 799, §4, is further amended to read:

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Members appointed by the Governor. Fourteen members shall-be are appointed for 5-year terms by the Governor, subject to review by the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over education and confirmation by the Legislature, except as provided in subsection 3. Each term shall empire expires on May 26th of the appropriate year, except that the retiring member shall serve until a successor is appointed by the Governor and confirmed by the Legislature. No person accepting such an appointment may be a member of the State Board of Education. In making appointments, the Governor shall strive to achieve a membership which is representative of the population of this State. In-so-far Insofar as feasible when selecting qualified nominees to the board, the Governor shall consider action criteria, professional. education affirmative experience and an equitable geographical representation among the Two of the trustees must be faculty trustees who have doctoral degrees and are teaching faculty members and not administrators. One must be from the field of humanities or social sciences and one from the field of natural sciences. The 2 faculty trustees must be selected so that for any concurrent 5-year terms of the 2 faculty trustees, one must represent the University of Maine and the other must represent a campus in the southern part of the State excluding the University of Southern Maine or one must represent the University of Southern Maine and the other must represent the northern part of the State excluding the University of Maine. The 2 possible combinations of representation of faculty trustees must alternate every 5 years. Trustees may serve a maximum of 2 terms, except that individual appointed to fill an unexpired term of 3 years or less is eligible for appointment to 2 full terms. Vacancies shall must be filled by the Governor, subject to review by the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over education and confirmation by the Legislature, for the unexpired balance of the term. In order to restore and maintain rotation of terms of office of trustees, an incumbent trustee who was appointed for a term of 5 years at a time subsequent to the expiration of the term of his the trustee's predecessor in office shall-be is deemed to have commenced his the 5-year term upon the date of the expiration of the term of office of his the trustee's predecessor rather than from the date of his appointment and

qualification. Trustees shall serve without compensation, but may be reimbursed for travel and other expenses incurred in the performance of their official duties.

Student members. One Two of the members shall must be a full-time student students at ene--ef--the campuses of the University of Maine System at the time of appointment and shall must be a permanent resident residents of the State. eligible as a student member, a student must be enrolled for a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester. The student member shall-be-a members are full voting member members of the Board of Trustees, and shall serve for a 2-year term terms and until a successors are qualified. The Governor shall nominate the student member members from a list of 5 eligible students submitted by the University of Maine System organization of student governments. The nemination-shall nominations must be made within 30 days of receiving the list of names and shall-be are subject to review by the Jeint--Standing--Committee--on Education joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over education and confirmation by the Legislature. The 2 possible combinations of representation of student trustees must alternate every 2 years.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill revises the composition of the Board of Trustees of the University of Maine System to include 2 teaching faculty members and an additional student member. Geographical delineation is also included as a requirement in appointing the teaching faculty and student members.
