COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 256, L.D. 347, "RESOLUTION,
Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution of Maine to Provide
for 4-year Terms for Senators and Members of the House of
Representatives"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement
of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The estimated cost to send this resolution out to referendum
will vary according to the total number of referenda. The
estimated cost to the Secretary of State if one to 6 referenda
are enacted is \$95,000. Each additional referendum will cost an
additional \$6,500.'

This amendment adds a fiscal note to the original bill.
