An Act to Ensure Adequate Stocking of Washington County Atlantic Salmon Rivers.



12 MRSA §6252-A, sub§6 is enacted to read:
6. Stocking. In any year that it conducts an Atlantic
salmon stocking program, the commission shall allocate a minimum
of 15% of the commission's total Atlantic salmon smolt production
to the following Washington County rivers:
A. Dennys River;
B. East Machias River;
·
C. Machias River;
D. Narraguagus River; and
E. Pleasant River.
STATEMENT OF FACT
This bill requires the Atlantic Sea Run Salmon Commission to
allocate a minimum of 15% of its total Atlantic salmon smolt
production to Washington County Atlantic salmon rivers in any
vear it conducts a stocking program.
