#### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE

An Act to Amend the Requirements to Become a Licensed Private Investigator.



Be it enacted by t	the People of	the State of	Maine as follows:
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32 MRSA §8112, as enacted by PL 1981, c. 126, §2, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

### §8112. Ineligibility of public officials

A person is eligible for a license under this chapter who derives plenary or special law enforcement powers from the State or any political subdivision of the State as long as that person is not involved with any investigation pertaining to any criminal matter or any civil matter involving the State or the political subdivision from which that individual receives plenary powers or compensation.

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#### STATEMENT OF FACT

20 This bill allows the issuance of a private investigator's license to an individual who receives plenary or special law 22 enforcement powers from the State or any political subdivision of the State as long as that individual is not involved with any 24 investigation pertaining to any criminal or civil matter involving the State or a political subdivision of the State.
