2 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not
become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted
as emergencies; and

6 **Whereas,** the Special Commission to Study and Evaluate the
Status of Education Reform in Maine is currently operating
without funds and will not be able to continue its work without
8 money; and

10 **Whereas,** in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
12 Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
14 safety; now, therefore,

16 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

18 **Appropriation.** The following funds are appropriated from
the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
