HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 157,  
L.D. 369, Bill, "An Act to Repeal Legislative Salary and Benefit  
Increases Granted in 1989"

Amend the amendment by striking out everything after the  
title and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place  
the following:

'Amend the bill by striking out all of sections 2 to 6.

Further amend the bill by inserting after section 6 the  
following:

'Sec. 7. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated  
from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

APPROPRIATIONS

General Fund                      (\$200,817)                      (\$134,386)

This bill will result in General Fund savings to the  
Legislature totaling \$200,817 in fiscal year 1991-92 and \$134,386  
in fiscal year 1992-93. These amounts could be deappropriated  
from the Legislature. However, the Governor's current services  
budget proposes significant reductions to the legislative  
accounts. If these reductions are enacted, the Legislature may  
not be able to realize the amount of savings above.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment leaves intact the reduction for legislative  
salaries only commencing in December of 1991 and removes the  
language that would reduce per diem and other expenses. The  
amendment also makes necessary adjustments to the appropriation  
section and inserts a new fiscal note.
