Further amend the bill by inserting after section 6 the 24 following:

'Sec. 7. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

Further amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following: 2 4 **'FISCAL NOTE** 6 1991-92 1992-93 8 **APPROPRIATIONS** 10 (\$200,817) General Fund (\$134,386) 12 This bill will result in General Fund savings to the 14 Legislature totaling \$200,817 in fiscal year 1991-92 and \$134,386 in fiscal year 1992-93. These amounts could be deappropriated from the Legislature. However, the Governor's current services 16 budget proposes significant reductions to the legislative accounts. If these reductions are enacted, the Legislature may 18 not be able to realize the amount of savings above.' ' 20 STATEMENT OF FACT 22 24 This amendment leaves intact the reduction for legislative ... salaries only commencing in December of 1991 and removes the language that would reduce per diem and other expenses. The 26 amendment also makes necessary adjustments to the appropriation section and inserts a new fiscal note. 28
