COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 157, L.D. 369

2        This bill will result in General Fund savings to the  
Legislature totaling \$437,067 in fiscal year 1991-92 and \$378,136  
4        in fiscal year 1992-93. These amounts could be deappropriated  
from the Legislature. However, the Governor's current services  
6        budget proposes significant reductions to the legislative  
accounts. If these reductions are enacted, the Legislature may  
not be able to realize the amount of savings above.
