COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 160, L.D. 372, Bill, "An Act to Correct the Registration of the Thorncrag-Stanton and Woodbury Sanctuary with the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife"

Amend the bill by striking out all of the title and inserting in its place the following:

'An Act to Correct the Registration of the Thorncrag, Davis and Woodbury Sanctuaries of the Stanton Bird Club with the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife'

Further amend the bill in section 7651 in subsection 1 in the blocked paragraph in the first line (page 1, line 7 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "~~Thorncrag-Stanton~~" and inserting in its place the following: 'Thorncrag' and in the 24th line (page 1, line 30 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "~~Sanctuary~~" and inserting in its place the following: 'Club'

Further amend the bill in section 7651 in subsection 1 in the blocked paragraph (page 2, line 39 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "~~northeasterly~~" and inserting in its place the following: 'northwesterly'

Further amend the bill in section 7651 in subsection 1 in the blocked paragraph (page 3, line 16 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "more or less." the following: 'A certain lot or parcel of land situated in Lewiston, bounded and described as follows: Beginning at a point on the southeasterly line of the original Stanton Bird Club Sanctuary, three hundred sixty-four (364) feet northeasterly from the northeasterly line of Montello Street; thence in a northeasterly direction by land now or formerly of the Stanton Bird Club, three hundred and sixty-eight (368) feet; thence in a southeasterly direction, parallel with the said northeasterly line of Montello Street, two hundred and forty (240) feet; thence in a southwesterly direction parallel with the first described line, three hundred sixty-eight (368) feet; thence in a northwesterly direction parallel with the said northeasterly line of Montello Street, two hundred forty (240) feet to the point of beginning, containing two (2) acres

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2 more or less, Deacon Davis Bird Refuge: The following described
3 territory: A certain parcel of land situated in the city of
4 Lewiston, in the county of Androscoggin, and bounded as follows:

6 Further amend the bill in section 7651 in subsection 1 in
7 the blocked paragraph by striking out all of the last 11 lines
8 (page 3, lines 24 to 34 in L.D.) and inserting in their place the
9 following: 'less, Woodbury Sanctuary: The following described
10 territory: A certain parcel of land situated in the towns of
11 Litchfield and Monmouth in the county of Kennebec and bounded as
12 follows: The westerly side of Whippoorwill Road, so called,
13 Being all the land conveyed to the Stanton Bird Club by Louise S.
14 Drew and Clara B. Dana by deed dated July 2, 1929 and recorded in
15 Kennebec County Registry of Deeds in Book 669-Page 210.'

16 Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the
17 statement of fact the following:

18 **FISCAL NOTE**

20 Costs associated with the erection of additional signs for
21 the sanctuary will be absorbed by the Department of Inland
22 Fisheries and Wildlife utilizing existing budgeted resources.'

26 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

28 This amendment corrects the description of the Thorncrag,
29 Davis and Woodbury Sanctuaries of the Stanton Bird Club.

32 This amendment also adds a fiscal note.
