Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §226, sub-§1, ¶E, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 463, §3, is amended to read:

E. Any person who is qualified under the law to use the title "professional engineer," provided such person may do only architectural work as is incidental to his the person's engineering work; or

Sec. 2. 32 MRSA §226, sub-§1, ¶F is enacted to read:

F. Horticulturists acting within the scope of their profession or occupation.

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

This bill exempts horticulturists from the law requiring licensure of architects and landscape architects.
