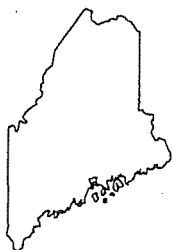

An Act Concerning Transferral of Cumulative Grade Point Averages of  
University of Maine System Students.

---



2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 20-A MRSA §10907-A is enacted to read:

6 §10907-A. Transfer of cumulative grade point average

8 Each campus within the University of Maine System must  
10 accept the cumulative grade point average of students who  
12 transfer credit hours from within the University of Maine System  
14 or from any regionally accredited 4-year college or university.

16 STATEMENT OF FACT

18 This bill permits students transferring academic credit  
20 within the University of Maine System or transferring academic  
22 credit from a regionally accredited 4-year college or university  
to the University of Maine System, to also transfer their  
cumulative grade point average. As a result, students who  
transfer academic credit from eligible institutions will also  
transfer their cumulative grade point average.
