COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 268, L.D. 388, Bill, "An Act to Provide Payment of Restitution to the Offices of the District Attorneys"

Amend the bill in that part designated "§1326." in the first paragraph in the 6th line (page 1, line 13 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "must" and inserting in its place the following: 'may' and in the 8th line (page 1, line 15 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "case" the following: 'or to the clerk of the court' and in the 9th line (page 1, line 16 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "must" and in inserting in its place the following: 'may'

Further amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

There will be no fiscal impact upon state departments or agencies. There are added costs to county government as a result of collecting and disbursing restitution payments. These county costs can not be estimated at this time.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment allows the court to order restitution to be paid to the prosecuting attorney, the clerk of the court or, if the person is on probation, to the Division of Probation and Parole.

This amendment also adds a fiscal note.
