COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 281, L.D. 401, Bill, "An Act to Increase the Availability of Funding for Health Care"

Amend the bill in section 3 in subsection 2-A in the last line (page 1, line 45 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "public" the following: 'and is licensed by the Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation under Title 34, section 1203-A'

Further amend the bill in section 3 in subsection 4-C in the 3rd line (page 1, line 49 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "facility" the following: 'that is exempt from taxation under Section 501 of the United States Internal Revenue Code and'

Further amend the bill in section 4 in paragraph A in the 7th line (page 2, line 13 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "facility," the following: 'congregate housing facility,' and in the 9th line (page 2, line 15 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "whether congregate or not,"

Further amend the bill in section 6 in subsection 1 in the 26th and 27th lines (page 3, lines 40 and 41 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "or community mental health facilities"

Further amend the bill in section 15 in that part designated "**§2058.**" in the first paragraph in the 3rd line from the end (page 7, line 20 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "may" and inserting in its place the following: 'is' and by striking out the following: "be" and inserting in its place the following: 'be'

Further amend the bill in section 19 in subsection 2 in the

3rd line from the end (page 8, line 26 in L.D.) by striking out
the following: "or community mental health facility"

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment clarifies the type of facility eligible to participate in projects under the Maine Health and Higher Education Facilities Authority Act, corrects a reference to congregate housing facilities to reflect more accurately the intent of the original bill and makes corrections for technical accuracy.
