HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 169,  
L.D. 403, Bill, "An Act to Enhance Medical and Social Services  
for Maine's Long-term Care Consumers"

Amend the amendment in section 3 by inserting at the end the  
following:

'Notwithstanding this section, if the procedures for  
requesting and accepting proposals are challenged under the laws  
or constitution of this State or the Federal Government, the  
Department of Human Services is not required to continue the  
proposal process or to establish the mail-order option.'

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

This amendment ensures that if the procedures for selecting  
a bidder for the mail-order option in the elderly low-cost drug  
program are challenged legally, the Department of Human Services  
is authorized to stop the bidding procedure and is not required  
to establish the mail-order option.
