**An Act to Increase Allowable Earnings under the Disability Retirement
Laws.**



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2
3 5 MRSA §17906, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1985, c. 801, §§5
4 and 7, is amended to read:

6 1. Compensation in excess of \$15,000. If, in any year, the
7 compensation received from engaging in any gainful occupation by
8 a beneficiary of a disability retirement benefit exceeds \$10,000
9 \$15,000:

10 A. The excess shall must be deducted from the disability or
11 service retirement benefits during the next calendar year,
12 the deductions to be prorated on a monthly basis in an
13 equitable manner prescribed by the board over the year or
14 part of the year for which the benefits are received; and

15 B. The beneficiary shall reimburse the retirement system
16 for any excess payments not deducted under paragraph A.

21 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

23 This bill raises the amount from \$10,000 to \$15,000 that a
24 beneficiary of disability retirement may earn before that
25 disability benefit is reduced.
