An Act Regarding Relicensure of Transfer Stations, Stump Dumps and Recycling Centers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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38 MRSA §1310-N, sub-§6-A is enacted to read:

6-A. Relicensing requirements. The department may not
require additional engineering or operational requirements to
relicense existing and operating transfer stations, stump dumps,
recycling centers or facilities operated for disposal, storage or
handling of white goods, tires or brush that have had no major
changes in operation since the previous license was granted. The
board shall define major changes in operation by rule.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill exempts existing transfer stations, stump dumps, 18 recycling centers or facilities that handle white goods, tires or brush from undergoing additional engineering or operational 20 requirements as part of their relicensing.
