# STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE

An Act to Require Local Development Corporations to Hold Open Meetings.

### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

5 MRSA 3081, sub- 5, as amended by PL 1989, c. 914, 3, is further amended to read:

6 б. Local development corporation. "Local development corporation" means any nonprofit organization created by a municipality; incorporated under Title 13, chapter 8 81; incorporated under Title 13-B or otherwise chartered by the State; and designed to foster, encourage and assist 10 the settlement or resettlement of industrial, manufacturing, fishing, agricultural, recreational and other business enterprises within 12 the State. A majority vote of the municipal officers is 14 sufficient form a local development corporation, to notwithstanding Title 13, chapter 81. Notwithstanding this subsection, a "local development corporation" is any nonprofit 16 organization incorporated under Title 13, chapter 81; incorporated under Title 13-B or otherwise chartered by the 18 State: and designed to foster, encourage and assist the settlement or resettlement of industrial, manufacturing, fishing, 20 agricultural, recreational and other business enterprises within 22 the State that applies for financial assistance for a project under this article, as long as that application is formally 24 endorsed by a vote of the governing body of the municipality in which the project is to be located. No local development corporation may receive public funds unless its board meetings 26 and meeting records regarding the use and expenditures of those funds are open to the public. 28
