COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 172, L.D. 427, Bill, "An Act Relating to Discrimination in Membership in Golf and Country Clubs"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This bill expands the jurisdiction of the Maine Human Rights Commission to include golf clubs and country clubs as places of public accommodation. The Maine Human Rights Commission can absorb the costs of enforcing the provisions of this bill within its available resources.'

This amendment adds a fiscal note to the bill.
