(EMERGENCY)

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	Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not
2	become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted
	as emergencies; and

	Whereas, the disposal of hazardous waste continues to be a
б	pressing environmental concern to the citizens of the State; and
0	Whereas, the uncertainty of the protection of ground water
8	for future generations remains a threat; and

	Whereas, it is important that any uncertainty be resolved
12	before any commitment is made to locate a commercial hazardous
	waste disposal facility in this State; and

	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
16	create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
	Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
18	necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
	safety; now, therefore,
