An Act to Prevent Discrimination.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to extend to all citizens
regardless of their sexual orientation the same civil rights
protections now guaranteed to citizens on the basis of race,
color, religion, sex, age, national origin and physical or menta

public accommodations and credit would be prohibited.

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
