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**Resolve, to Increase the State's Funding Share for the Augusta Capitol  
Street and Armory Street Project.**

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2           **Capitol Street and Armory Street project; increase of State's funding**  
3 **share. Resolved:** That the Department of Transportation shall  
4 exempt the Augusta Capitol Street and Armory Street  
5 reconstruction project from its policy on the funding ratio for  
6 urban system highways, which requires such projects to receive  
7 75% federal funds, 20% city funds and 5% state funds. For this  
8 project, the portion funded by the State is 25% and the portion  
9 funded by the City of Augusta is 0%.

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#### STATEMENT OF FACT

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This resolve exempts the Augusta Capitol Street and Armory  
15 Street project from the Department of Transportation funding  
16 ratio for urban system highways. The resolve increases the  
17 state-funded portion of the project from 5% to 25% in light of  
18 the State Government's impact on the streets surrounding the  
19 State House and state offices and the tax-exempt status of state  
20 property in Augusta's total valuation.
