### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE

Resolve, to Increase the State's Funding Share for the Augusta Capitol Street and Armory Street Project.



Capitol Street and Armory Street project; increase of State's funding share. Resolved: That the Department of Transportation shall exempt the Augusta Capitol Street and Armory Street reconstruction project from its policy on the funding ratio for urban system highways, which requires such projects to receive 75% federal funds, 20% city funds and 5% state funds. For this project, the portion funded by the State is 25% and the portion funded by the City of Augusta is 0%.

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#### STATEMENT OF FACT

This resolve exempts the Augusta Capitol Street and Armory Street project from the Department of Transportation funding ratio for urban system highways. The resolve increases the state-funded portion of the project from 5% to 25% in light of the State Government's impact on the streets surrounding the State House and state offices and the tax-exempt status of state property in Augusta's total valuation.
