An Act to Amend the Definition of Aquaculture.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

39 MRSA §2, sub-§11, as enacted by PL 1981, c. 70, §1, is
4 amended to read:

6 11. **Aquaculture.** "Aquaculture" means the commercial
7 culture, pounding or husbandry of oysters, clams, scallops,
8 mussels, salmon ~~or~~, trout or lobsters.

12 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

13 This bill amends the definition of aquaculture to include
14 employees whose work involves lobsters under the alternative
15 liability and medical insurance provision provided by the
16 Workers' Compensation Act.
