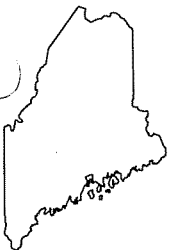

An Act Related to Workplace Safety Incentive Programs.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

26 MRSA §2-A is enacted to read:

§2-A. Prohibition of safety programs that award prizes

An employer may not operate a safety program in which employees are given prizes or other consideration for working a designated number of hours without a workplace injury.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to prohibit incentives that encourage employees not to report workplace injuries.
