**An Act to Amend the Maine Residents Property Tax Program for Elderly
Households.**



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

36 MRSA §6206, sub-§4 is enacted to read:

4. Income limitations for certain elderly households. For all elderly households whose income does not exceed \$30,000, the benefit is 100% of that portion of the benefit base that exceeds 4.5% of the household income up to a maximum of \$3,000.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill increases the tax refund benefits for all elderly households whose income does not exceed \$30,000 to 100% of that portion of the benefit base that exceeds 4.5% of the household income to the present maximum payment of \$3,000.
