22	The estimated cost of sending this resolution out to referendum will vary according to the total number of referenda.
24 26	The estimated cost to the Secretary of State if one to 6 referenda are enacted is \$95,000. Each additional referendum costs an additional \$6,500.
28	If this constitutional amendment is passed by the voters, additional costs of approximately \$150,000 would be incurred by
30	the State for election years requiring a runoff election. In addition, the total cost to municipalities for such an election
32	would range from \$75,000 to \$100,000.'
