COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 319, L.D. 449, "RESOLUTION,  
Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution of Maine Requiring the  
Governor-elect to Receive More than 50% of the Votes Duly Cast"

Amend the resolution by inserting at the end before the  
statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The estimated cost of sending this resolution out to  
referendum will vary according to the total number of referenda.  
The estimated cost to the Secretary of State if one to 6  
referenda are enacted is \$95,000. Each additional referendum  
costs an additional \$6,500.

If this constitutional amendment is passed by the voters,  
additional costs of approximately \$150,000 would be incurred by  
the State for election years requiring a runoff election. In  
addition, the total cost to municipalities for such an election  
would range from \$75,000 to \$100,000.'

This amendment adds a fiscal note to the original resolution.
