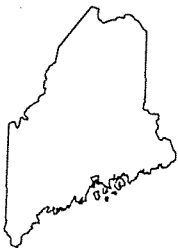

An Act to Provide Funds to the Maine Rural Water Association for
Services to Water and Wastewater Systems.

(EMERGENCY)



Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, this Act appropriates funds for fiscal year 1991-92 which begins before this Act would otherwise be effective; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

Provides funds for the Maine Rural Water Association to assist municipalities and sewer districts with sewer improvement and other related activities. These funds may not lapse and must be carried forward to the next fiscal year.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill provides \$100,000 each year of the 1992-93 biennium to the Maine Municipal Bond Bank to be used by the Maine Rural Water Association to assist municipalities and sewer districts with sewer improvements and other related activities.
