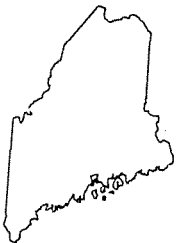

An Act to Require Legislators to File Their Own Travel Expenditures.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2
3 MRSA §2, as amended by PL 1989, c. 878, Pt. D, §§14 and
4 15, is further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to
read:

6
7 In order to receive reimbursement for expenses that are
8 authorized by this section and for which receipts or vouchers are
9 required, each member of the Legislature requesting reimbursement
10 must submit separate receipts or vouchers reflecting only that
11 Legislator's expenses.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to ease the administrative
burden of processing legislative travel and expense vouchers.
This bill requires that, in order to receive reimbursement for
authorized expenses, each Legislator must submit separate travel
and expense vouchers and receipts that reflect only that
Legislator's expenses.
