IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE

An Act Concerning the Lobster Harvesting License Fee for Persons 70 Years of Age or Older.

	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	12 MRSA §6421, sub-§7-A, as enacted by PL 1989, c. 455, §2,
4	is amended to read:
6	7-A. Fee. The fee for the license shall-be is:
8 10	A. \$26 for a Class I license for applicants under 17 years of age;
12	B. \$53 for a Class I license for applicants 17 years of age or older; and
14	<u>B-1. Notwithstanding paragraph B, \$53 for a Class I license</u> for applicants 70 years of age or older who have held
16	lobster and crab fishing licenses for 5 of the previous 10
18	years. The fee established in this paragraph may not be increased above \$53; and
20	C. \$159 for a Class II license.
22	STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill freezes the license fee for lobster licenses at \$53 for applicants 70 years of age or older and requires that anyone applying must have had a license for 5 years.
