An Act to Suspend Administratively Certain Licenses Granted by the Department of Human Services.

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### STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill allows the Department of Human Services to suspend a license for a children's home, child placing agency, day care facility or nursery school for up to 30 days without a court order. The Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 10004, requires that a hearing be scheduled in Administrative Court before the end of 30 days or the emergency order expires automatically.
