COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 180, L.D. 489, Bill, "An Act to Change the Specifications for Membership of the Maine Dental Health Council"

Amend the bill in the indented paragraph in the 8th to 10th lines (page 1, lines 13 to 15 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "2 professional staff, at least one of whom must be a registered dental hygienist employed at least 1/2 time by a public or private nonprofit dental clinic program" and inserting in its place the following: '2 staff employed at least 1/2 time by a public or private nonprofit dental clinic program, one of whom must be a registered dental hygienist and one of whom must be a dentist or other professional staff.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment clarifies that one of the professional staff selected from a clinic setting may be a dentist.
