HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 203, L.D. 530, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Fair Credit Reporting Laws"

Amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 2-A in the 2nd line (page 1, line 24 in L.D.) by inserting after the underlined word "agency" the following: 'in connection with an initial application for consumer credit'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment clarifies that users must request social security numbers only in connection with initial credit applications and not for prescreening operations or for routine review of credit reports for existing customers of the users.
