COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 207, L.D. 534, Bill, "An Act Pertaining to Community Corrections Programs"

Amend the bill at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause (page 1, line 28 in L.D.) by inserting the following: 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the emergency clause the following:

'Sec. 2. Allocation. The following funds are allocated from Other Special Revenue funds to carry out the purposes of this Act.

Provides for the allocation of funds for community corrections programs. These funds represent 30% of all funds claimed by counties for reimbursement and retained by the department until counties demonstrate that the funds will be used for community corrections programs.'		

2 Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the
4 statement of fact the following:

6 **FISCAL NOTE**

8 This bill requires that funds retained by the Department of
10 Corrections from community corrections funds be placed in an
12 interest-bearing account and interest accrued be paid to the
14 county when funds are released. This will result in a loss of
16 revenue to the General Fund in the amount of \$35,000 in fiscal
18 year 1991-92 and \$50,000 in fiscal year 1992-93. An allocation
of the retained funds and associated interest to the Department
of Corrections is being made in the amount of \$480,719 in fiscal
year 1991-92 and \$640,958 in fiscal year 1992-93 for community
corrections and juvenile diversion programs. The above amounts
may vary depending upon the timing of payments to the counties.'
