## ·FISCAL NOTE

This bill requires that funds retained by the Department of Corrections from community corrections funds be placed in an interest-bearing account and interest accrued be paid to the county when funds are released. This will result in a loss of revenue to the General Fund in the amount of \$35,000 in fiscal year 1991-92 and \$50,000 in fiscal year 1992-93. An allocation of the retained funds and associated interest to the Department of Corrections is being made in the amount of \$480,719 in fiscal year 1991-92 and \$640,958 in fiscal year 1992-93 for community corrections and juvenile diversion programs. The above amounts may vary depending upon the timing of payments to the counties.'
