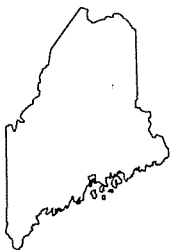

**An Act to Provide Access to Preventive Dental Care Services to Adults
Eligible for Medicaid.**



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2 Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §3174-F, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1989, c.
4 502, Pt. A, §72, is repealed.

6 Sec. 2. 22 MRSA §3174-F, sub-§1-A is enacted to read:

8 1-A. Coverage provided. The department shall provide
10 preventive, diagnostic and corrective dental services, reimbursed
12 under the federal Social Security Act, Title XIX, 42 United
14 States Code, Section 1396d (1990), to individuals 21 years of age
16 and over, including treatment of:

18 A. The teeth and associated structures of the oral cavity;
20 and

22 B. Disease, injury or impairment that may affect the oral
24 or general health of the recipient.

26 Sec. 3. 22 MRSA §3174-F, sub-§2, as repealed and replaced by
28 PL 1989, c. 904, is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

26 This bill adds preventive, diagnostic and corrective care to
28 the list of dental services available to adults eligible for
Medicaid.
